

1. Updated Return to Face to Face Learning plan – Covid 19

Activities allowable as of 15 June – with Principal's discretion:

- All Department of Community and Justice activities including: external services to support eg: counselling services, domestic and family violence services, family support services, targeted early intervention programs
- School assemblies (limited to 15 minutes and no external visitors permitted)
- Choirs and performing arts within school setting only at this point (no inter-school activities). Strict Hygiene protocols in place and sign off for external visitors to site
- Incursions /external adult providers to support delivery of curriculum (e.g. Sportspro - Term 3 & 4). Must maintain distancing and hygiene requirements.
- Students may attend other schools for essential curriculum related reasons or placements (e.g. HS auditions or placement tests)
- Activities using hydrotherapy pools
- Day field trips to outdoor locations with no physical distancing requirements (e.g. DoE Environmental Education Centres and sport and recreation facilities, trips to local river to collect water samples)
- Face to face TAFE attendance in line with TAFE schedule
- Community use student activities eg. dance classes and student sport skills development eg. Michael Pupo – Martial Arts sport program
 - related activities that are outside of school hours but on school site,
 - preferably held outside or in large area
 - **strict hygiene protocols & operators sign off & acknowledgement is required**
- Community use activities on weekends involving adult attendance (complying with relevant guidelines) not essential to continuity of education
- School photos for students (although no group staff photos).

Activities allowed from beginning of Term 3

- All school sport and activities including competitions aligned with current health advice (including those activities run by external organisations)
- Inter-school student events and competitions (choirs, sport, debating, public speaking, performing arts, Selective Sports High School trials etc). DoE has provided a list of creative arts & sport activities that have been cancelled for the year
- Incursions not already permitted involving external adult providers maintaining distancing and hygiene aligned with the health advice of the day (eg school banking talks, sport promotions etc – not directly curriculum related)
- SRE/SEE volunteers – external visitor sign off & strict hygiene & social distancing required

- Parent/teacher meetings
 - if there is a need to take place, involving serious matters that require face to face discussion
 - **strong preference for online** where possible unless involving serious matters that require face to face discussion
- P&C meetings – strong preference for on-line where possible
- Parent/carer school pick up and drop off
 - arrangements should continue taking into consideration adult physical distancing requirements.
 - Parents/ carers should not be on school grounds or at school events without principal's permission.
- Share Our Space
- Official visitors and dignitaries
- Non-essential adults are still not permitted on school site or at school events

2. Changes to planned School Development Day Professional Learning Days

School staff unable to run external professional learning session on Talk 4 Writing as had been planned.

- Term 3 – Monday 20 July – SDD – pupil free day – one day professional only
- P – 6 students return Tuesday 21 July – Friday 25 September
- Term 4 – P – 6 students return – Monday 12 October – Wednesday 16 December
SDD – Thursday 17 & Friday 18 December – Team Kids – Vacation sessions begin

3. Properties:

Programmed maintenance work still being undertaken throughout many areas of the school.
Weather is not helpful at present.

Cooler Classrooms update – notification that commencement date is set for Term 4 2021.

End 2018 – cooler classroom project to provide air conditioning with in the various classrooms in the school.

Solar Schools Project – CBP grant of \$17500 – need to put in AMU forms & start the ball rolling to get the tender process underway.
